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## Gate Attendant Openings at Lake Shelbyville

**Lake Shelbyville-** The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is looking for people interested in becoming gate attendants at Lake Shelbyville. At the present time, there is one attendant position open in the Bo Wood campground for the 2013 recreation season. The work required by the Bo Wood position runs from April 8, 2013 through October 26, 2014.

Services performed by gate attendants include greeting and registering campers, collecting camping fees, and operating the campground entrance station fee booth. Gate attendant contracts at Lake Shelbyville require two (2) people to perform the work. The individuals chosen for these positions will attend a three (3) day computer training session and a two (2) day gate attendant orientation before beginning work in the campground fee booth. The training and orientation will be provided by the Corps of Engineers at the Lake Shelbyville Visitor Center.

A full hookup campsite will be provided for the gate attendants selected to perform this work. Gate attendant campsites include water, sewer, and 50 amp electrical service. Gate attendants must provide their own self contained camping unit and are required to reside in the campground on days they are scheduled to work.

Persons interested in gate attendant work must be registered in Central Contractor Registration (CCR) before gate attendant jobs can be awarded to them. Gate attendant positions are paid positions. Interested individuals are required to submit an hourly bid price for the work to be performed. Bid packages for these positions may be obtained on-line. To print a bid package go to [www.mvs.usace.army.mil](http://www.mvs.usace.army.mil). Once at the web site click on "BUSINESS", then click on "CONTRACTING". On the "Contracting Opportunities" page, click on the "ASFI – The Army Single Face to Industry" link. Once in ASFI, select solicitation Number W912P9-13-T-7018. If you are unable to obtain the Lake Shelbyville Gate Attendant bid package from the internet a bid package can be mailed to you.
