Summer Student Employment Available at Lake Shelbyville

Lake Shelbyville – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Lake Shelbyville is currently accepting job applications for summer student employment for the 2012 recreation season. Students hired will be required to begin work at the completion of the Spring 2012 semester and work until the beginning of the Fall 2012 semester. Available job openings have not been decided at this time but possibly available in Interpretive Services, Visitor Assistance, Facility/Grounds Maintenance and Environmental Stewardship. Hourly rate for these positions is \$10.95 with a 40 hour per week work schedule. If hired for these positions, you may be required to work days and/or nights and weekend shifts.

To be eligible a student must meet the following minimum requirements:

1. Must be at least 18 years of age.
2. Must have been enrolled or accepted for enrollment in a degree-seeking program and be taking at least a half-time (6 hours) course load the semester prior to employment.
3. Must have and maintain at least a 2.0 grade point average.

To apply applicants should submit the following:

1. Personal resume or OF612 – Optional Application for Federal Employment.
2. Letter from college or university verifying enrollment and good academic standing.
3. Original transcript of grades for each semester/quarter of school.
4. Original class schedule of classes in which student is currently enrolled.
5. Information requested in Job Application Packet.

A job application packet can be picked up at the Lake Shelbyville Project Office, which is located near Shelbyville, IL off of IL Route 16 or on-line at www.mvs.usace.army.mil/Shelbyville.

Application packets must be received at the Lake Shelbyville Project Office no later than 4 p.m. on February 1, 2012 in order to be considered an applicant for the 2012 summer recreation season.
